

THE EFFECTIVENESS OF DEBATES IN ENGLISH SPEAKING DEVELOPMENT

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Abstract. Annotatsiya. Ingliz tilini o'rganishda og'zaki nutq ko'nikmalarini rivojlantirish eng murakkab va muhim jihatlardan biri hisoblanadi. Ko'plab o'quvchilar grammatik bilimlarga ega bo'lsa-da, o'z fikrlarini erkin va ravon ifodalashda qiyinchiliklarga duch keladilar. Bu holat ta'lim jarayonida interaktiv va o'quvchi markazidagi metodlardan foydalanish zarurligini ko'rsatadi. Debat metodi o'quvchilarning faol ishtirokini ta'minlaydigan, tanqidiy fikrlashni rivojlantiradigan va tilni real muloqot jarayonida qo'llashga undaydigan samarali usullardan biri hisoblanadi. Ushbu maqolada debatlarning ingliz tilida gapirish ko'nikmalarini rivojlantirishdagi samaradorligi tahlil qilinadi. Tadqiqot natijalari shuni ko'rsatadi, debatlar o'quvchilarning nutq ravonligi, aniqligi, ishonchi va kommunikativ kompetensiyasini sezilarli darajada oshiradi.
